EPHESUS

Ephesus is one of the best preserved ancient cities around the Mediterranean, and among the most spectacular places in the world to enable one to genuinely 'soak in' the atmosphere of Roman times. Associated with this place are the significant biblical figures of St. Paul, St. John the Evangelist and the Virgin Mary.

Ephesus is the most famous of the Seven Churches of Revelation (Rev 2:1-7) where St Paul spent more than two years in the course of his third missionary journey. It was to the Christian community of Ephesus that St Paul wrote his greatest and most challenging letter (the epistle to the Ephesians) and also succeeded in converting many away from worship of the god Artemis.

It is said that Mary spent the later years of her life here in the House of the Virgin Mary. A significant event occurred in Ephesus in the Third Ecumenical Council (431AD), where through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, Mary was proclaimed "Mother of God".

It is believed that St. John, author of the Gospel of St John and the Book of Revelation, spent his last years in the region around Ephesus and is buried amid the ruins of St John's Basilica on Ayasoluk Hill in nearby Selcuk.
